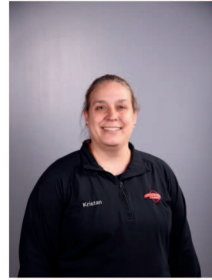




WHERE DO I BEGIN?

WELCOME TO MINI-MITE ACADEMY

This academy is designed for skaters who have an interest in playing hockey and would like to develop the necessary skills to be able to participate in our hockey program.

Skaters are required to have participated in our Learn-to-Skate program and have completed (evaluation sheets will indicate when the skater has passed the level) classes through Tot Advanced and/or the Pre-Alpha class.

Skaters will develop and improve their skating skills and receive proper training on playing related skills such as: stick handling, puck handling, and shooting. Skaters in this academy will be 6 years old or younger.
